National hamradio organization ZRS & EmComm



- In 2015 103 radioclubs were members of national hamradio organization ZRS. All radioclubs have around 1.100 radioamateurs.
- ZRS is an IARU member since 1992 and the same year ZRS steering committee has announced Amateur radio emergency network code called ARON.
- Every HAM in S5 has to respect <u>ARON code</u> which is introduced to the candidates during the HAM course.
- ARON code has 11 Articles which describes how every HAM should act in case of emergency situtation.
- In 2002 ZRS has signed a co-financing contract with Administration for Civil Protection and Disaster Relief of Republic Slovenia
- ZRS has prepared two documents
- Standards for organizing, training and equip of hamradio ARON teams
- Plan of activation for ARON teams



In accordance with the contract ZRS has to ensure:




- 13 regional and a one national level ARON team
- ■HF communication from each of the 13 regions (RNC, regional CP HQ) to a NNC and/or National CP HQ
- a plan for communication through repeater network and VHF/UHF simplex channels
- data transfer through hamradio digital networks (Packet radio, Winlink)
- international hamradio traffic with neighbour and other affected countries or countries where Slovenia send rescue & protection teams
- availability of ARON teams for immediate response for interventions
- Plan of activation and Standards for organizing, training and equip of hamradio ARON teams
- education and exercises for ARON teams
- cooperation of ARON teams in exercises which are organized by Ministry of defence, ACPDR and others involved in rescue and protection system




Organization chart of ARON teams













Members of ARON teams have a task to:



- establish communication from Regional notification centre to National notification centre and vice versa
- establish communication between Regional CP HQ and Regional notification centre 112 and vice versa
- establish communication between Regional CP HQ and National CP HQ and vice versa
- to cooperate with all rescue and protection teams and give them all the necessary communication support



ARON team



- Licensed hams, members of radioclubs
- Every team has:
 - Team leader,
 - HF operator,
 - VHF operator
 - o DIGI comm operator.



Team members don't wear CP uniforms. They can be recognized with the ZRS and ARON emblems on their clothes, vests and caps. In a case if they need protection clothes on the place of accident, CP will ensure them.



Who can activate ARON teams



- From NNC by the order of:
 - CP commander or his deputy
 - Director general of ACPDR or his deputy
 - President of ZRS
 - National ARON coordinator or his deputy
- From RNC by the order of:
 - Regional CP commander or his deputy
 - Leader of Regional branch of ACPDR
 - Leader of the Regional ARON team
- Self activation of ARON teams is also possible especially when public communications systems fails



Education & exercises



- Every first Wednesday in a month ARON teams have SKED's
 - > At 1800 hrs local time on 3605 KHz SSB
 - > At 1900 hrs local time on repeater network
 - At 2000 hrs training with Winlink system (WINMOR, PACTOR, Packet radio)



Consequences: falling trees, power lines, telephone lines, blocked roads, telecommunication breakdown, power blackout...











- Professional communication systems were down (old batteries on repeaters, broken antennas) mobile professional repeater installation by ARON team
- GSM is down
- Hams are standby on simplex 145.425 Mhz and VHF repeater R1 on mountain Nanos (temp. Echolink connection to conference *SLOVENIA*)





Today at 1000 CET the Emergency Radio Coordinator of Lower Austria, Karl OE3KYS was ask to support the Fire Departments currently on their way to Slovenia with 120 Diesel power generators.

As it is currently unclear how the teams from Austria can communicate with their control in Austria, Austrian HAM EmmComm was asked to establish a link between Austria and Slovenia with Pactor/Winlink.

I ask all European Station to keep the frequencies of the Slovenian and Austrian Winlink RMS free from any traffic not related to the emergency communications.





Hi Tilen,
