Agenda of the meeting

Peter, HB9CET, Vice Coordinator of the IARU Monitoring System (R1) presented an overview of the today's situation and problems in our bands. He also pointed clearly out, that not every emission in our bands is an intruder!

The presentation included the following main topics of IARUMS today:

- IARUMS R1 structure and member societies
- Short history
- Intruders – an overview
- Our possibilities
- Military transmissions
- Hard- and Software
- Information + Communication within IARUMS R1
- Must we modernize?

This was followed by a discussion about possibilities to make IARUMS Information's more contemporary and flexible:

- Creating a real-time online Logger
- Creating a database with audios, pictures, technical data about signals from Intruders in a similar structure as our written reports.
- Publishing as much data as possible about Intruders and their signals.

As a result, the WG established a sub-working group to prepare as a correspondence group a more detailed proposal for creating an online Logger/Database. Members of the sub-WG are: HB9CET, DK4VW, DF5JL, OD5RI, F4GFR, and SP7TEV.

It is expected that the sub WG will present a test version of such a system at the next Interim Meeting of the C4 committee.
